It is compulsory that pupils wear the official school uniform at all times during College hours, on journeys to and from College and for official College business.

Navy blazer with maroon braid and School Crest

Clip on Tie (navy and maroon with yellow stripe)

White Shirt

Navy Blue Kick Pleat Skirt

Black trousers

Grey / navy socks or tights

Plain flat black shoes or black trainers only. No boots or trainers of any other colour.

Grey “V” neck jumper with burgundy stripe. The jumper is compulsory and must be worn at all times.

Plain navy raincoat - longer than blazer

Students must not wear hoodies or any other type of coloured overcoat in school or on the journey to and from school. Plain navy or black scarf may also be worn.

While coloured hair is very common it should look natural. Hair should be kept neat. While highlights are allowed gaudy hair colours e.g. bright red, blue, pink, etc, extreme styles e.g. hair extensions and shaved heads are not allowed (should be **minimum** No 2).

Students may wear a maximum of one small stud earring at the bottom of their ears. One small ring is allowed. Nail varnish and make up are not permitted. **Other piercings are not permitted.**

P.E Uniform - £40.00 - available to be purchased from school.

What should I bring to School

Oakgrove is a UNICEF Rights Respecting School which means that we put the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child at the centre of what we do. Article 28 says “Children have a right to an education”. To help you get this, we ask you to bring certain things to school.

When you arrive at Oakgrove Integrated College, you will be given text books, exercise books and other equipment which will help you to enjoy and be successful in your subjects.

There are also some items which you will be expected to bring to school with you.

Some of these are needed in almost every subject, so you should bring them along every day.

These are:

- Pens (blue and red)
- Pencils, eraser, sharpener, ruler, colouring pencils, felt tip pens, Pritt stick

There are some items which you will only need if you have a certain subject on that day. For example:

Technology and Mathematics:

A compass, set square, markers, protractor, scientific calculator.

PE Kit

Home Economics – An apron. A tin or box (Tupperware) to take food home.
